#### 40/21 Update on the Alfred Bean Hospital Steering Group/Project Group:

The clerk reported that she would call a steering group meeting for Thursday or Friday June 10/11<sup>th</sup> to update the members on the progress of the Project Group. She commented that Daniel Vulliamy's recent email did outline issues that were not included in the remit set by the town council or the steering group to herself and the chair of the group, Cllr Mark Blakeston. A recission notice would be required if the Town Council wished to take the approach and issues raised in the email to the Project Group. Cllr M Blakeston commented that he had much respect for the knowledge and points made by Mr Vulliamy and that unless council directed otherwise, it may be that he wished to pursue these issues himself or on behalf of the Driffield Labour

Party, or indeed the Steering Group, should they wish. Cllr T Watson requested copies of the Project Group minutes, which the clerk said she would check if she was able to distribute and if so, would do so. Cllr K McLeod commented that Mr Vulliamy had mentioned registering the Alfred Bean as a Community Asset and that this may be something that the town council could consider in the future. Cllr M Blakeston commented that if he had to bring that to the Project Group it would render the work, they were assigned to complete, almost impossible as this is currently at total odds with the desired outcome of the Project Group that the Alfred Bean Hospital remains open and still at the centre of medical services in Driffield as a health and wellbeing centre.

The clerk assured the council of the Project Groups commitment to Alfred Bean Hospital and that this was central to the two meetings already completed.
